## DAILY ITINERARY

---

### Day 1, UK/Medjugorje

We fly from London Gatwick to Split or Dubrovnik. Upon arrival, your guide and driver will be waiting to take you to your hotel in Medjugorje. The journey takes approximately 3 hours. So sit back and relax and enjoy the beautiful panoramic view of the countryside and the Adriatic Sea.

### Day 2, Medjugorje

After breakfast, we meet with our guide and walk to St James Church where we will have our concelebrated Mass. Afterwards we will have a guided walking tour of the Sanctuary and the surrounding area. We will have lunch and afterwards we will go to the Apparition Hill where our guide will explain all the information you long to hear on Our Blessed Mother's Apparition. Continue to visit the community of **Cenacolo**. This was founded by Sister Elvera Petrozzi in 1991 to support young people recovering from addictions and to teach them the simple way of life, with faith in Jesus, and to straighten their paths in life. *Taxi to Cenacolo not*

*included, approximately £1 each way (4 people sharing). Dinner at the hotel.*

### Day 3, Medjugorje

After breakfast, we meet with our guide and walking from the back of St James church we climb **Mount Krizevac** (Cross Mountain) a kilometre away from the church of Medjugorje, 520 metres above sea level. We have Stations of the Cross on the way to the mountain. Please note that to go up the mountain you have to be reasonably fit, and be very careful as the mountain has rough rocks and stones to tackle. The Gigantic Cross you see up here was erected by local people in 1933 to commemorate the 1900th anniversary of our Jesus' Crucifixion. Enjoy the view at the summit and relax before the descent. After lunch, we leave Medjugorje and drive to the village of **Surmanci** where we celebrate Mass in the Church of the Merciful Jesus. In the church, there is a miraculous icon of Jesus of Mercy. This icon was in the Sanctuary of Divine Mercy in Trento where Ugo Festa was miraculously healed when he prayed before it. It also has a small relic of St Faustina. We return to

Medjugorje and have lunch here. Free for the remainder of the day. Evening dinner at the hotel.

### Day 4, Medjugorje/Mostar

Today we explore outside Medjugorje and visit the medieval Old City of **Mostar**. The highlight is the famous Old Bridge of Mostar built in the 17th century. Sadly, this was largely destroyed during the Bosnia and Herzegovina war between 1992 and 1995. It is now being restored to its former glory. We celebrate Mass here. We then move on to visit the beautiful **Waterfalls of Kravice, the biggest waterfalls in Bosnia Herzegovina - they span 120m and fall 80 feet, a truly spectacular unspoilt natural attraction.** We stay here for two hours before returning to Medjugorje.

### Day 5, Medjugorje/Dubrovnik

We leave Medjugorje and drive to Dubrovnik. On the way we stop at the **Vepric Holy Shrine** for Mass (subject to time availability). This shrine is dedicated to Our Lady of Lourdes. Continue our journey to Dubrovnik. *At this point, the part of the group that paid for Medjugorje only will travel to Dubrovnik airport for their flight back to London Gatwick.* The remainder of the group will enjoy

lunch and afterwards check in to our hotel and stay overnight here.

### Day 6, Dubrovnik

After breakfast, we walk to the ancient entrance of Dubrovnik's medieval Old town and we visit the Franciscan Monastery which is located just within the walls. Move on to visit Dubrovnik Cathedral of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, built on the remains of two earlier churches (you must be dressed appropriately or they will ask you to leave). The Cathedral contains a rich collection of around 200 reliquaries. Among them are the arm, skull and leg of St Blaise the patron of Dubrovnik. Dinner at the hotel.

### Day 7, Dubrovnik/UK

Free time until we depart for the airport and our flight back to London Gatwick.
